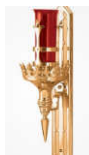

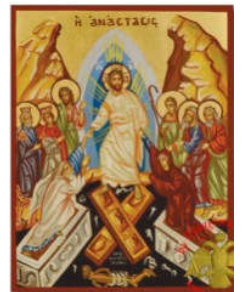

THE SANCTUARY LAMP

According to the Byzantine Missal "In accordance with traditional custom, near the tabernacle a special lamp, fueled by oil or wax, should be kept alight to indicate and honor the presence of Christ." It is also a sign to indicate the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

In St. Stephen, the Sanctuary Lamp is on the wall to the right of the main altar.
