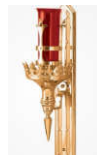

THE SANCTUARY LAMP

According to the Byzantine Missal “In accordance with traditional custom, near the tabernacle a special lamp, fueled by oil or wax, should be kept alight to indicate and honor the presence of Christ.” It is also a sign to indicate the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.



In St. Stephen, the Sanctuary Lamp is on the wall to the right of the main altar.

Jesus was living in Capernaum and teaching the people there, and on one occasion the people gathered in such large numbers that there was not room left inside the house. Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus. When Jesus saw their faith, he said, “Friend, your sins are forgiven.”

THE HOLY GREAT MARTYR GEORGE



George of Lydda, was an early Christian martyr who is venerated as a saint in Christianity. According to tradition, he was a soldier in the Roman army. He was sentenced to death for refusing to recant his Christian faith.
