TRANSFIGURATION OF OUR LORD - Aug. 6, 2024



After six days Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. There he was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus.

Safe Environment Program

Safe Environment Policies of the Archeparchy:

Prior to active employment or <u>participation in parish activities</u>, all employees and volunteers must complete the following: Criminal background clearance and child abuse history certification

These policies apply to all personnel (clergy, employees and volunteers) whether or not they have direct contact with children.

All participants must read the Safe Environment Educational Workshop in order to sign the Safe Environment Educational Workshop form.

The following will get you there.

Go to www.archpitt.org.

- 1. Click on the icon of Jesus and the children. (It takes you to the Safe Environment Program)
- 2. Click on Safe Environment
- 3. Scroll down to the Safe Environment Training Workshop
- 4. Click on the Safe Environment Education PDF and that will take you to the initial Power Point (COPIES OF FORMS ON COUNTERS IN ENTRANCE TO CHURCH)

Upon completion of forms:

(1) The Disclosure form MUST be sent or faxed to Sr. Joanne before she will be able to provide a code that is needed to complete the child abuse clearance.

- (2) Once the disclosure form is sent/faxed to Sr. Joanne, you must contact her to request a code to complete the clearance.
- (3) Parishioners can feel free to contact any of the Parish Council members with questions or for assistance.
