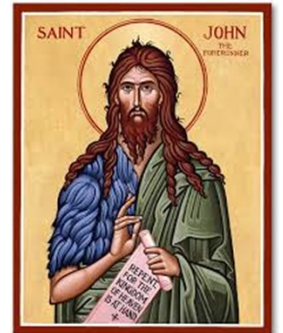

**BEHEADING OF JOHN THE BAPTIST**  
August 29th



According to the Gospels, Herod, who was tetrarch, or sub-king, of Galilee under the Roman Empire, had imprisoned John the Baptist because he reproved Herod for divorcing his wife and unlawfully taking Herodias, the wife of his brother Herod Philip . On Herod's birthday, Herodias' daughter (whom Josephus identifies as Salome) danced before the king and his guests. Her dancing pleased Herod so much that in his drunkenness he promised to give her anything she desired, up to half of his kingdom. When Salome asked her mother what she should request, she was told to ask for the head of John the Baptist on a platter. Although Herod was appalled by the request, he reluctantly agreed and had John executed by beheading in the prison. .

### **East Meets West: Women Icon Makers of West Ukraine**

You're cordially invited to *East Meets West: Women Icon Makers of West Ukraine* – an exhibition at the Verostko Center for the Arts at Saint Vincent College in Latrobe, PA. *East Meets West* pays tribute to 8 innovative artists, students of a new school of iconography in the cultural center of Lviv who blend traditional Byzantine iconography, modernist painting techniques, and elements of Eastern European folk art to visualize Christian narratives as both ancient and accessible. These women have pioneered a style of sacred art native to Ukrainian Greek Catholicism at a time when their nation defends itself from Russian invasion.
