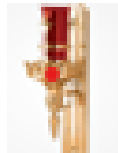

LENT

Lent is a period of extra prayer, fasting and penance once a year in preparation of Pascha, the Feast of the Holy Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Lent is always 40 days long. Lent is one of four periods of fasting in the Byzantine Liturgical year, and therefore, it is sometimes called Great Lent in the Church. Lent comes from the ancient English word which means “Lengthening of Days”, that is Spring.
