Lent is a period of extra prayer, fasting and penance once a year in preparation of Paska, the Feast of the Holy Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Lent is always 40 days long. Lent is one of the four periods of fasting in the Byzantine Liturgical year, and therefore, it is sometimes called Great Lent in the Church. Lent comes from the ancient English word which means “Lengthening of Days”, that is Spring. The other three traditional fast periods are a period of time before the Feast of Ss. Peter and Paul on June 29, two weeks before the Feast of the Dormition of the Mother of God on August 15, and 40 days before Christmas. The fast before Christmas is also call the Philipovka, which means “Philip’s Fast” because it begins on November 15, which is the day after the Feast of St. Philip.
