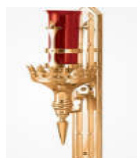

Hramoty - Remembrance of the Dead

In the Byzantine Catholic tradition, the All Souls, Hramoty, are special liturgical days dedicated to praying for the faithful departed. These special services provide an opportunity to fulfill the Church’s call to remember and intercede for our loved ones.

The Third All Souls— During this time, the Church reflects on Christ’s victory over death and prays for the departed to share in that victory.

Praying for the dead is not only a charitable act for the departed but also spiritually enriching for the living. It reminds us of the transitory nature of life and calls us to prepare for our own journey to eternity. It fosters humility, gratitude, and hope as we entrust our loved ones to God’s mercy while deepening our own faith in the resurrection.
