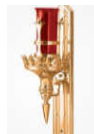

**EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS**



Exaltation of the Holy Cross, liturgical feast celebrated on September 14 **to honour the cross on which Jesus Christ was crucified.** In the Eastern churches the feast dates back to the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre (the site of Christ's tomb) in Jerusalem circa 335.

\*The feast day of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross will be celebrated on Friday, Sept. 13 as a vigil liturgy. This is because the Saturday liturgy is in anticipation of the Sunday Liturgy. When a holy day falls on a Saturday, the directive is to celebrate the feast day as a vigil, the day before.
